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### Notes/Narratives

BWC footage available:

On 09/10/2019, at approximately 2324 hours, I was dispatched to Arbol de la Vida Residence Hall (515 N. Tyndall Ave.) reference a fight in progress. Upon arrival I met with UA students [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] in front of Arbol de la Vida. Both stated [REDACTED] had been assaulted and the suspects walked away southbound, into a white house located on the [REDACTED]. They described one of the subjects as a white male, approximately 6'00" tall with curly hair, wearing either a striped or gray shirt. Corporal Timpani #1708 and Officer Mueller #0809 responded to the house where they contacted and detained the subjects identified as UA students Matthew Frazier and Matthew Rawlings (see supplements).

I spoke with UAS [REDACTED] who stated he and [REDACTED] were walking to [REDACTED] northbound in front of Arbol de la Vida. The subjects, Frazier and Rawlings, were walking southbound towards them [REDACTED] said they were calling him "the N word", then one of the males tripped, ran up and "tackled" him [REDACTED] said the male started punching him "in the head like five times". [REDACTED] said he was also kicked while on the ground by a second person. [REDACTED] did not know which subject ran towards him and added he could not describe either subject as everything happened so fast [REDACTED] was very upset over the use of the "N word" during the altercation, however he was unsure if the assault was racially motivated. When asked about what he was called [REDACTED] would only refer to it as "the N word" and said he couldn't deal with it. [REDACTED] sustained minor injuries consisting of scrapes on the back of his right hand (knuckles) and scrapes on both his right elbow and knee. Photographs of the injuries were taken and submitted to the DIMS. I offered [REDACTED] medical assistance, which he refused [REDACTED] stated he did not want to pursue criminal charges against Frazier or Rawlings.

I then spoke with UAS [REDACTED] who said he and [REDACTED] were walking to [REDACTED] from across the street, when the male subjects "started screaming at [REDACTED] for no reason [REDACTED] said he tried to calm them down when one of the subjects initiated contact with [REDACTED] causing them to end up on the ground [REDACTED] mentioned he and [REDACTED] had never met or seen the subjects before and didn't know why they were screaming at them. [REDACTED] also confirmed they were calling [REDACTED] "the N word."

I then spoke with UAS [REDACTED] who witnessed the altercation [REDACTED] said he was dropping off his girlfriend when he noticed [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] crossing [REDACTED] northbound and the two male subjects walking south towards them [REDACTED] said the subject with the gray shirt (Frazier) engaged [REDACTED] by tackling him to the ground and the second subject, wearing a white shirt (Rawlings), began kicking him. [REDACTED] added he could hear Rawlings calling [REDACTED] a "pussy ass bitch" while he was kicking him. I then drove [REDACTED] to conduct a show-up. [REDACTED] positively identified both Frazier and Rawlings as the subjects involved in the fight.

A Dean of Students Referral for [REDACTED] re: FYI was submitted to the DOS office. A Hate Crimes Reporting Guidelines worksheet was completed, and Victims Rights (P317167) mailed to [REDACTED] NFI 0613.

On 09/13/19 at 1100 hours I responded to [REDACTED] in reference to this case. Officers Theel and Geutersloh assisted and met me in the ally of the residence. The gates to the property were closed and I first telephoned Frasier. The call went straight to voice mail. I then called Rawlings and he answered. Rawlings identified himself and agreed to come out to the alley to speak with me. Rawlings came to the alley and I introduced myself. Rawlings provided his [REDACTED] driver's license which matched his likeness. I asked if Frasier was in the house. Rawlings stated that he was and he would go get him. Rawlings went back into the house and came back with Frasier. I then again introduced myself to both Rawlings and Frasier. I advised them that they were under arrest for assault (1104) for the incident the other night. They were permitted to grab shoes and wallet from their rooms. They were escorted while in their rooms. Frasier and Rawlings were handcuffed. Please see addendum's of Theel and Geutersloh for information on transport to jail. Frasier and Rawlings were booked for Assault-Intentionally Causing Physical Injury.

On 09/13/2019 at 1057 hours I responded to [REDACTED] with Sgt. Barrera (U984) and Ofc. Theel (U1217) to arrest Matthew Frazier and Matthew Rawlings in reference to this case.

Upon arrival, Sgt. Barrera made contact with Rawlings via telephone and requested he come to the back gate of their residence. When Rawlings and Frazier came to the back gate Sgt. Barrera advised them they were under arrest. I accompanied Frazier back inside to his room to get his shoes. We went back outside where I placed Frazier in handcuffs, double-locked them and checked for fit. I walked Frazier to my marked patrol car where I conducted a search incident to arrest. I located no contraband in my search incident to arrest. Frazier was seated in the rear passenger seat of my patrol vehicle, which had been checked for contraband at the beginning of my shift, and seat belted in. Frazier was transported to the Pima County Jail where he was booked for assault without incident.

This concluded my involvement with this case.

## Supplement Notes

I received and reviewed this case. This report will supplement the basic case report.

At approximately 1026 hours, I called UAS [REDACTED] for a follow up interview reference this case. As per my training and experience with victims of trauma, I contacted [REDACTED] after he had additional sleep cycles to allow for healing and possibly a more accurate account of what occurred. I started my UAPD digital audio recorder (DAR) and spoke with [REDACTED]. See DAR for exact wording and further detail.

-I introduced myself and we spoke briefly, as [REDACTED] was leaving for his class in 15 minutes.

[REDACTED] stated he felt pretty good, but his hand was in a lot of pain. He would see the campus doctor for his hand and a bump on his head to make sure he didn't have a concussion.

[REDACTED] was provided resources during the initial contact with patrol (on 09/10/19) and stated he received 5 business cards. I advised [REDACTED] of Campus Health resources in the event he wished to speak with a counselor about the incident.

[REDACTED] advised he would speak with [REDACTED] today and believed him to be a counselor [REDACTED] is listed in the UA Directory as a [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] had spoken with friends about incident.

-He spoke about being called the "N" word [REDACTED] said when the suspect came at him, he kept saying "you N word" as he was tackled and punched. It was said approximately 8-10 times during the full event.

[REDACTED] stated he freaks out when someone says the "N" word. He doesn't believe it should be said. It's 2019 and shouldn't be said especially from a white male.

[REDACTED] was not sure if this assault was racially motivated. He did not know these guys who did this or said this and had never had any contact with them before.

[REDACTED] clarified the specific statement made to him was, "You Nigger".

[REDACTED] said, what happened keeps repeating in his head, him being called that word. He said the incident replays (in his head) every day, every second and it is frustrating. Everytime he feels pain in his hand he is reminded of it.

-The most difficult part of this for [REDACTED] was what the suspect said. He added, "It is a huge no".

-I asked [REDACTED] if his wishes were still not to move forward with criminal charges. He said he might press charges [REDACTED] spoke to his mom and she said he should consider. I asked [REDACTED] if he wanted to schedule another interview to discuss his wishes to pursue criminal charges and he said yes.

[REDACTED] did not have anything additional to add to the conversation.

-I told [REDACTED] would text him my phone number so he could call me when he was ready to schedule another interview.

-We ended the call.

I stopped my DAR. Additionally, I requested it be transcribed which will be included with this case with the audio. I texted [REDACTED] with my

Narrative: On 09/10/19 at approximately 2324 hours I responded to Arbol de la Vida Residence Hall reference a report of a fight in progress. Ofc. Bermudez made it on scene first and advised that one party was there and the other involved party had fled. I checked the area around the Residence Hall but found no one. I was then advised by Ofc. Bermudez that the suspect may have ran into the [REDACTED] Cpl. Timpani and I approached the house and knocked on the front door.

There was a window next to the door that had the blinds up/open and I could see into the residence. As Cpl. Timpani continued to knock I saw a white male wearing a grey shirt and black shorts quickly peak out from a hallway. I confirmed with Ofc. Bermudez the description of the missing suspect and it matched the person I just saw. Timpani continued to knock and announce our presence at the door and the male reappeared, coming to the doorway. The male, later identified as Matthew Frazier, opened the door and stepped out onto the porch. Frazier appeared intoxicated (odor, demeanor) and had fresh blood on his shirt. Frazier advised there were two more people in the residence, and Ofc. Bermudez stated there was at least another male and [REDACTED] involved that had run from the scene as well.

As Cpl. Timpani detained Frazier I stood on the porch and called into the house that anyone else inside needed to come to the door. As I was doing this Cpl. Timpani noticed movement in the backyard. I continued to call into the residence until I saw a male and [REDACTED] emerge from a back room. The male, later identified as Matthew S Rawlings, followed my instructions and came to the doorway. Rawlings stepped out and was detained by Cpl. Timpani. I called several more times into the residence for the [REDACTED] to come out, but [REDACTED] never reemerged. It was decided that there was no indication the [REDACTED] was directly involved at the moment so I secured the front door (closed it) to the residence, and due to safety concerns (we did not have a complete picture of the entire incident and knew at least one person remained inside the residence) Cpl. Timpani and I moved Rawlings and Frazier to my vehicle at [REDACTED]

I advised Rawlings of his Miranda Rights to which he stated he understood them and would answer my questions. Rawlings explained that he was coming from Urbane apartments where he had picked up his heavily intoxicated friend, Frazier. They were with Rawling [REDACTED] and walking back to their residence. Rawlings said a black male [REDACTED] started yelling at Frazier from across the street a [REDACTED] and Frazier then tackled each other. Rawlings first said he was kicking Frazier and trying to get him to stop fighting; to get up and leave. When I pressed him on how sure he was about who he was kicking, admitted he did not fully remember if he was just kicking Frazier. When asked about who started the physical fight (who threw the first punch) Rawlings stated he did not remember. I consulted with Ofc. Bermudez via telephone who advised me that [REDACTED] was declining to press charges. I took overall photographs of Rawlings and close-ups of his shoes (the right shoe had a scuff mark consistent with kicking) for evidence in the event that the victim wishes to proceed with charges.

Rawlings appeared to be intoxicated; slurred speech, odor of intoxicants coming from his mouth. Rawlings advised me that he had consumed three alcoholic beverages earlier. I advised Rawlings that he was going to be Diverted through the Dean of Students Office in lieu of arrest for Minor in Possession of Alcohol. I also advised Rawlings that the altercation was also going to be sent to the Dean of Students Office as an FYI.

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Rawlings was released and went home.

While I had been interviewing Rawlings [REDACTED] approached me and advised me [REDACTED]

On 9/13/19 at approximately 1100 hours I responded to [REDACTED] along with Sgt. Barrera and Ofc. Guetersloh. When we arrived Sgt. Barrera made telephonic contact with Matthew Rawlings and requested that both he and Matthew Frazier step out. Rawlings appeared first and then Frazier shortly after. Both were placed under arrest for misdemeanor assault and I escorted Rawlings back to his room so that he could have a drink of water. I then placed Rawlings into handcuffs, double locked and checked for fit. I then searched Rawlings incident to arrest and seat belted him into the back of my caged patrol vehicle. I searched the prisoner compartment of my vehicle prior to and after the transport. I transported Rawlings to the Pirna County Jail. At PCJ Rawlings and Frazier were both booked for the one count of Assault.

#### Body Worn Camera Activated

On 09/10/2019, at approximately 2324 hours, I responded to the area of 6th and Tyndall regarding two males fighting in front of of Arbol De La Vida dorm (515 Tyndall Ave).

Upon arrival while in the area, Ofc. Bermudez (#0613) explained a victim witnessed the other males involved run to a house on the [REDACTED] [REDACTED] Myself and Ofc. Mueller (#0809) knocked and announced ourselves. Ofc. Mueller advised he saw a white male coming to the door matching the description provided by Ofc. Bermudez (White male with grey shirt and dark blue shorts). The male later identified as UAS Matthew Frazier opened the door and walked outside on the porch. I could see blood on his arms as well as his shirt. He was detained and placed in handcuffs and sat on the porch. Frazier stated there was another male inside named Matthew and [REDACTED] with him still inside. The other male came to the door and exited and he was placed in handcuffs on the porch. We attempted to have the [REDACTED] come to the front door and Ofc. Mueller witnessed [REDACTED] walk into another room with negative contact. We shut the front door and left the area of the front yard.

I then walked Frazier to Ofc. Ugalde's car for further questioning just [REDACTED] Ofc. Mueller walked the other male to his patrol vehicle for interviewing. I read Frazier his Miranda rights to which he understood and responded "Yes sir" and "Yes sir" to answering my questions. Frazier stated the following to my questions. He was only at his house and had never left. He could not provide the names of who he was with. He stated he was never at any of the dorms on campus. When asked about the abrasions on his arm he denied having them. I took a picture to show him what was on his right arm and he stated he didn't know what I was talking about. When asked about the blood on his shirt he stated "I don't know". He stated he did not know who was in the altercation. I asked if he was on any medication to which he answered "No", I asked if he drank any alcohol to which he answered "No". I could smell a strong odor of intoxicants coming from Frazier. He had slurred speech and his eyes were red bloodshot and watery.

During the questioning I had Frazier step out of the vehicle and Ofc. Bermudez had a witness positively identify Frazier as involved in the fighting.

Ofc. Bermudez advised his victim did not want to press charges against Frazier.

I photographed all the injuries sustained for documentation. Frazier did not want to seek any medical attention when asked. I advised Frazier that I would be completing a Code of Conduct to the Dean of Students and he stated he understood. He walked back to his residence.

All photographs were placed into the Digital Imaging Management System (DIMS) at the station and Student Code of Conduct was completed.
